Dear Ms. Drain:

After researching your association's questions, I have found there have been no changes in policies regarding certification of school librarians since Commissioner Sampson wrote Barbara Bryson, President of ASLA, in November, 2006.

Alaska certifies individuals based on the following type of program they complete:

1. School Librarian, or
2. Library Science and Media Specialist.

With regard to Initial teacher certification in Alaska: Should a person complete an approved teacher preparation program in School Library and receive an Institutional Recommendation stating the same, he/she would be issued an Initial teacher certificate with a School Librarian endorsement.

With regard to Type C Special Services certification: Should a person complete a special services program in a library area and receive an Institutional Recommendation stating the same, he/she would be issued a Type C certificate endorsed in the library area indicated on the Institutional Recommendation.

With regard to additional endorsements on certificates: When a teacher who holds a Type A or Professional teacher certificate completes a program and receives an Institutional Recommendation in a library area, he/she may add the library endorsement to his/her Type A or Professional teacher certificate while continuing to have his/her content area endorsement remain on the certificate. When a person who holds a Type C Special Services certificate completes a program and receives an Institutional Recommendation in a library area, he/she may add the endorsement to his/her Type C certificate.

With regard to renewal of a certificate: When a person holding a Type A or Professional teacher certificate with an endorsement in a library area and another content area renews a certificate, all endorsements remain on the certificate. When a person who holds a Type C Special Services

certificate endorsed in a library area renews a certificate, the endorsement remains on the certificate.
